Where is the answer?

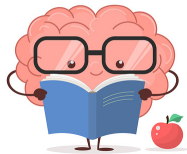


What type of question is it?

In the Book

In my Head

Right There



The answer is easily found in the text. You could probably highlight the correct answer.

Example: Where did the family live?

From text: The family lived in **California**.

Think and Search



The answer is found in several parts of the text. You will need the different pieces to answer the question correctly.

Example: Why did the family move?

Summary from text: The dad got a new job.

Summary from text: The mom wanted to live closer to her sisters.

Author and Me



The author does not state the answer directly. However, by using what you know and listening closely to what the author is telling you, the answer can be found.

Example: Do you think the family should move?

I know that moving is a difficult decision.

This passage suggests...

On My Own



The answer is not in the text. You must use your own knowledge and experiences to answer the question.

Example: How would you feel if you were told that you were moving next summer?
